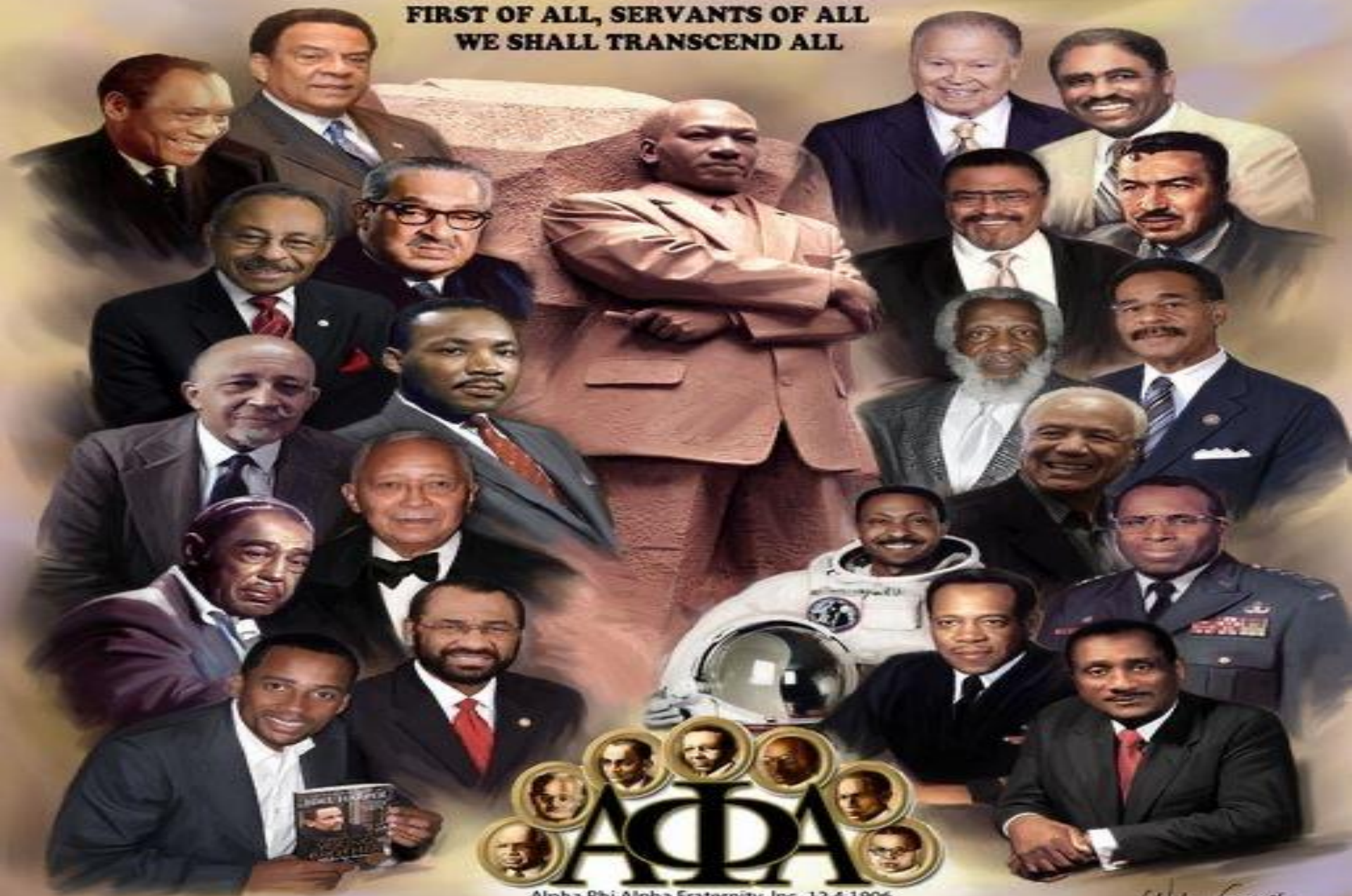

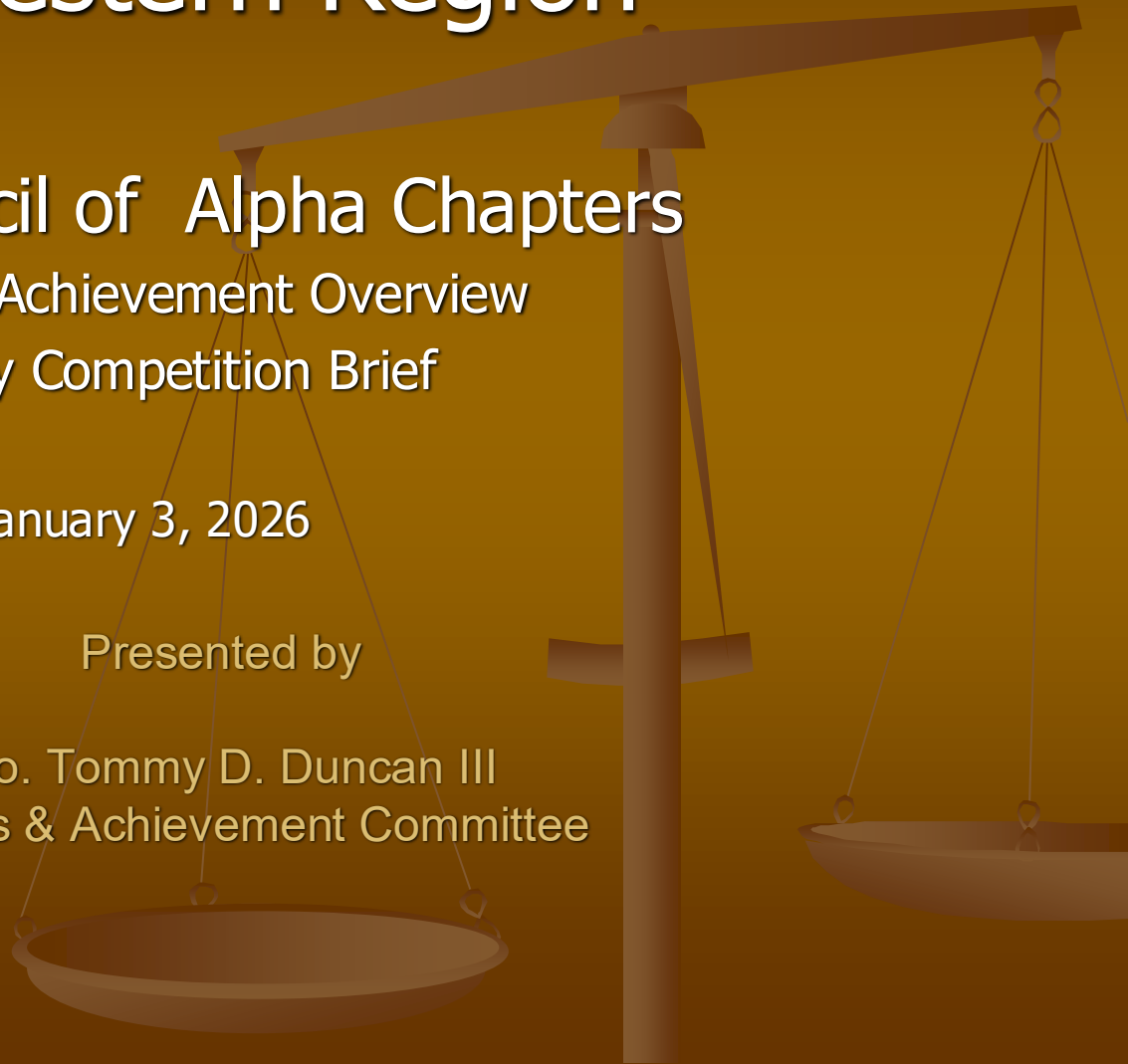

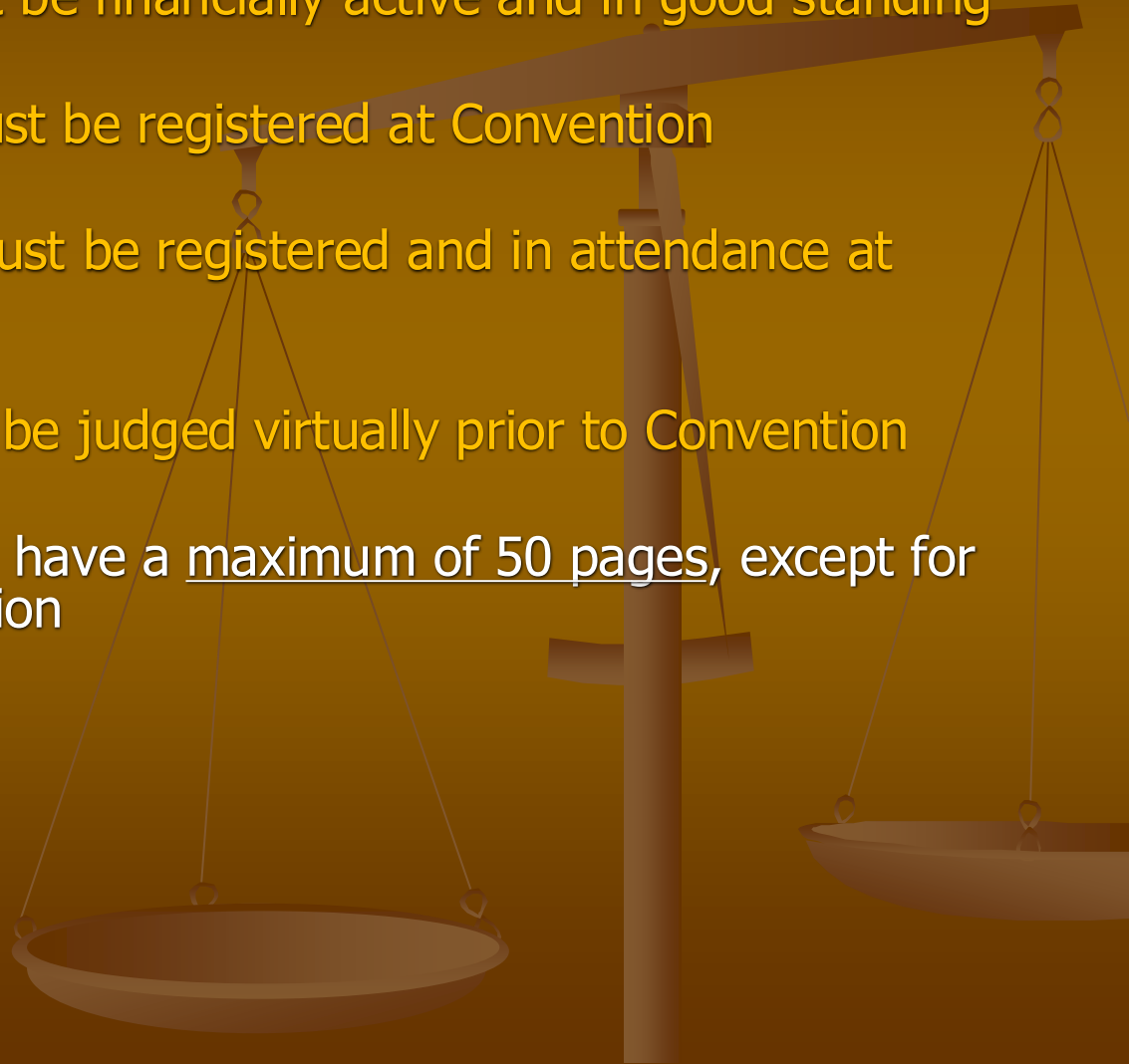

# General Guidelines

- Chapters competing must be financially active and in good standing
- Full delegate strength must be registered at Convention
- All brothers competing must be registered and in attendance at Convention
- Display Competitions will be judged virtually prior to Convention
- Display presentations will have a maximum of 50 pages, except for Best Scrapbook Competition




# Competition Workflow

- All display competitions will be judged (virtually) prior to convention:
  - Brother of the Year
  - Chapter of the Year
  - Charles H. Wesley
  - Best Scrapbook





# Guidelines for Display Competition Interviews

- Brother of the Year, Chapter of the Year, and Charles H. Wesley
    - 10 minute virtual interview presentation with judges
    - Digital presentation (e.g. PowerPoint, PDF, etc.) may complement presentation
    - Secure digital file folders will be created for each chapter
    - Digital content will be uploaded into file folders in District's Google Drive
    - Information from prior to current convention (Except Scrapbook & where rubric allows)
  - Displays are to be neatly organized to ensure easy navigation
    - Strong, Clear Chapter Theme
    - Table of Contents with pagination
    - Images of plaques, medals, trophies, news articles, etc. are permissible
    - Videos (MP4) may be used to support presentation
  - Best Scrapbook Competition
    - Historical Narrative of Chapter Accomplishments since inception
    - Stand Alone Document (No judges interview)
  - Prior Convention Presentations archived on TCAC Website

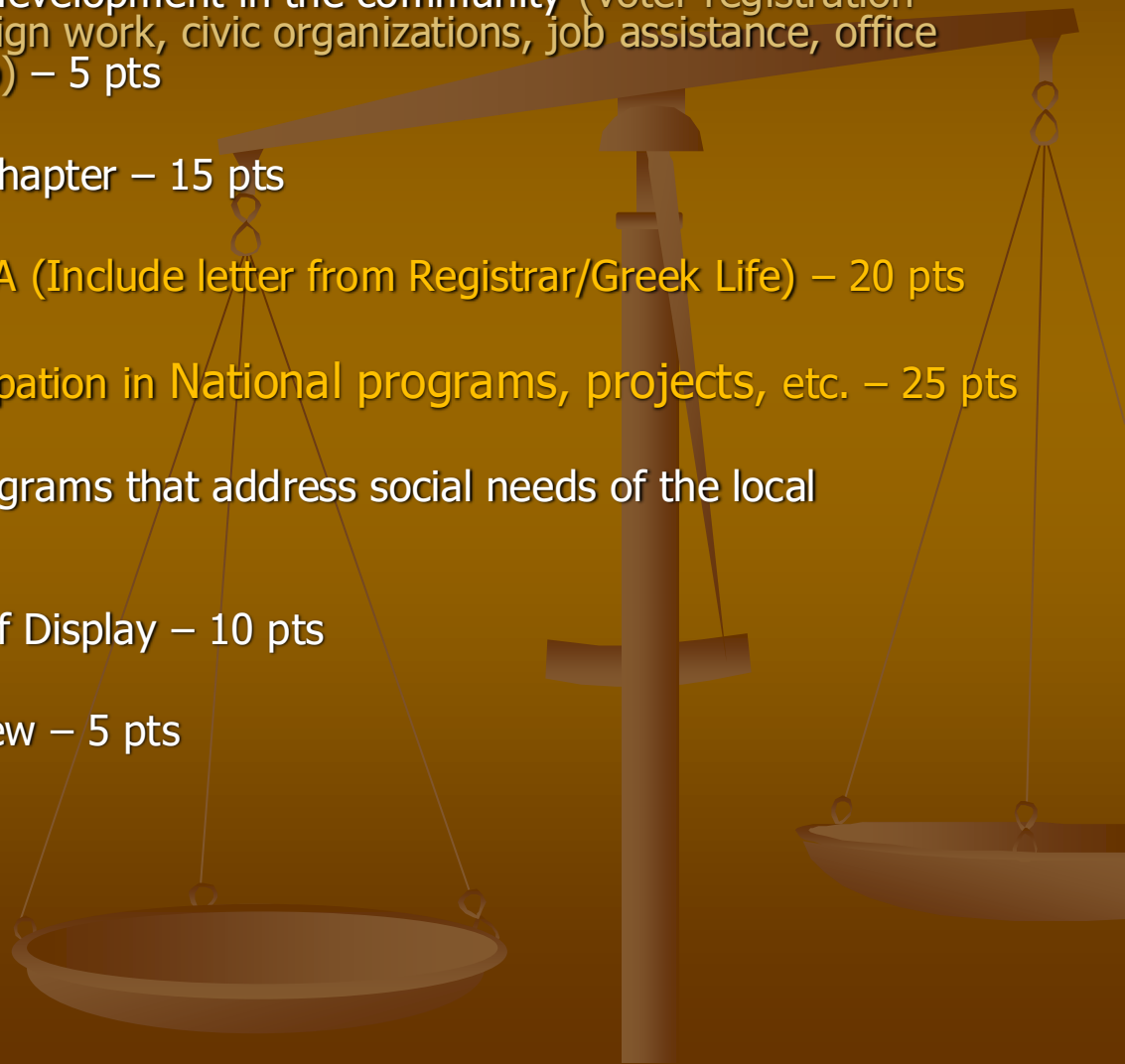
# College Brother of the Year

- Contribution to Fraternity at all levels (Participation and involvement in Chapter, Area/District, Region and General Organization activities - Delegate to conventions, offices held, committee service as a member or chairman, participation in Alpha Programs and Projects, ) – 10 pts
  - Contributions to College/University Community (Campus Orgs & Activities, Student Government, Pan Hellenic/IFC, etc.) – 10 pts
  - Awards and Achievement (List of Awards & Achievement, with Doc) – 15 pts
  - Academic Standing/GPA (Include transcript in prez – 15 pts
  - Demonstrated National Programs, Initiatives, Assessments – 30 pts
  - Innovative chapter initiated programs to address unique needs of local community – 5 pts
  - Appearance & Organization of Display -10 pts
  - Performance on Judges Interview – 5 pts

# College Chapter of the Year

- Contributions to the growth of personal service to the chapter members (Risk Management/IMPD certified, Training, Scholastic/Leadership activities) – 10 pts
- Contributions to the economic development in the community (voter registration drives, lobbying groups, campaign work, civic organizations, job assistance, office holders, and campus leadership) – 5 pts
- Awards and Achievements by Chapter – 15 pts
- Academic Standing/Chapter GPA (Include letter from Registrar/Greek Life) – 20 pts
- Demonstrated degree of participation in National programs, projects, etc. – 25 pts
- Innovative chapter initiated programs that address social needs of the local community – 10 pts
- Appearance and Organization of Display – 10 pts
- Performance on Judges Interview – 5 pts

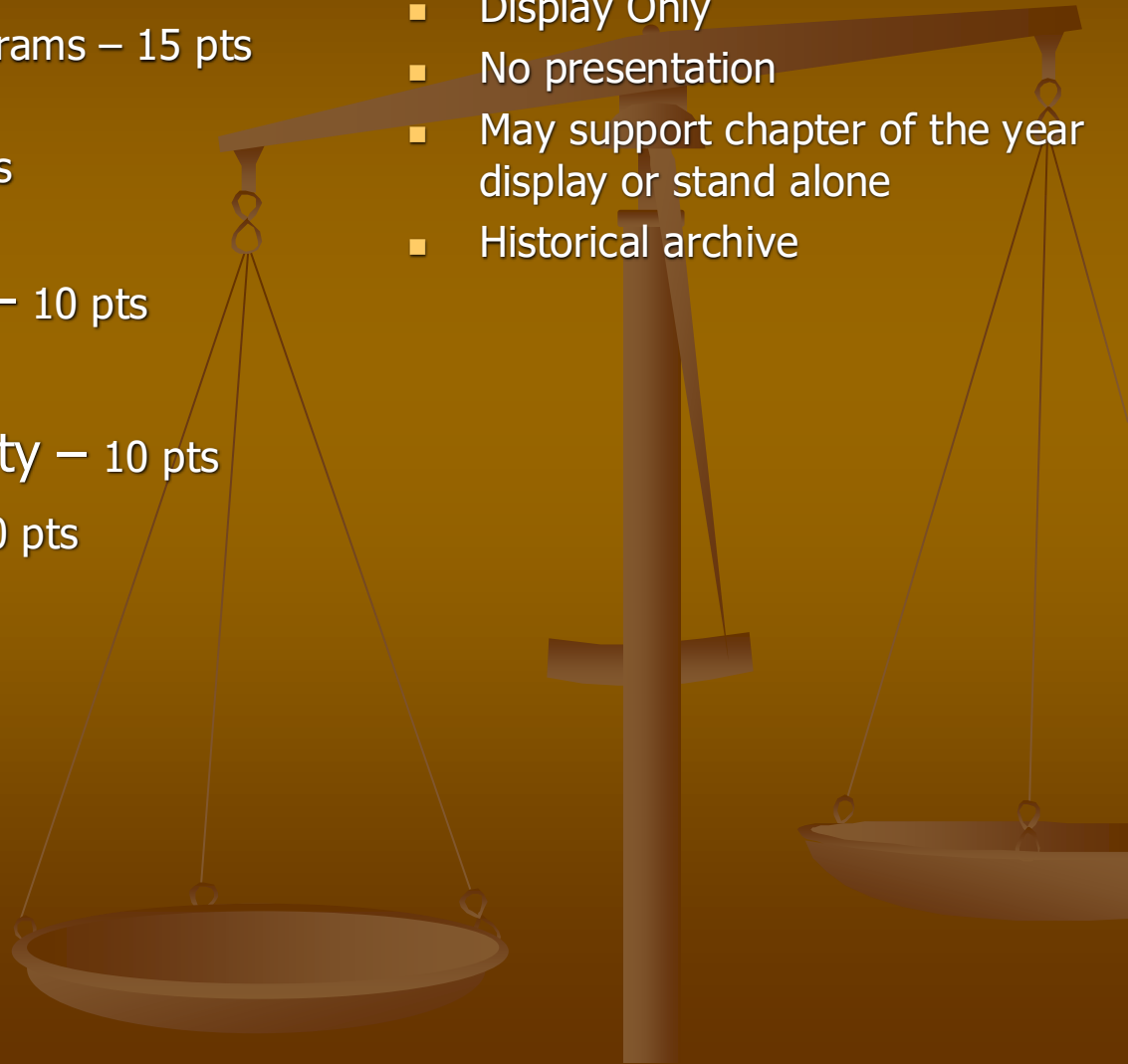


# College Scrapbook Competition

# Alumni Brother of the Year

- Contribution to Fraternity at all levels (participation and involvement in Chapter, Area/District, Region and General Organization activities- delegate to conventions, offices held, committee service as a member or chairman, etc.) - 15 pts
  - Contributions to Economic Development Community (List documentation for church, businesses, civic associations, political, personal, social services) – 10 pts
  - Awards and Achievement (Medals, Scholarship, Merit Achievement) – 10 pts
  - Years of Active Participation in Fraternity (List with documentation - this is not how long you been a member) – 15 pts
  - Participation in National Programs (Go To High School, Voteless People, BBBS, Project Alpha, Boy Scouts, Brothers Keeper) – 25 pts
  - Innovative chapter initiated programs to address unique needs of local community – 10 pts
  - Appearance & Organization of Display -10 pts
  - Performance on Judges Interview – 5 pts

# Alumni Chapter of the Year

- Contributions to the growth of personal service (Risk Management/IMPD certified, Scholastic/Leadership activities, training programs, etc.) – 5 pts
- Contributions to the economic development in the community (civic leadership/development, job assistance, campaign worker, civic organizations, service foundations, etc.) – 10 pts
- Awards and Achievements - 20 pts
- Years of Active participation in Alpha at all levels (National, Region, District, Area, Local) – 10 pts
- Demonstrated participation in Alpha National programs, projects, etc. – 25 pts
- Innovative chapter initiated programs addressing social needs of community – 15 pts
- Appearance and Organization of Display – 10 pts
- Performance on Judges Interview – 5 pts

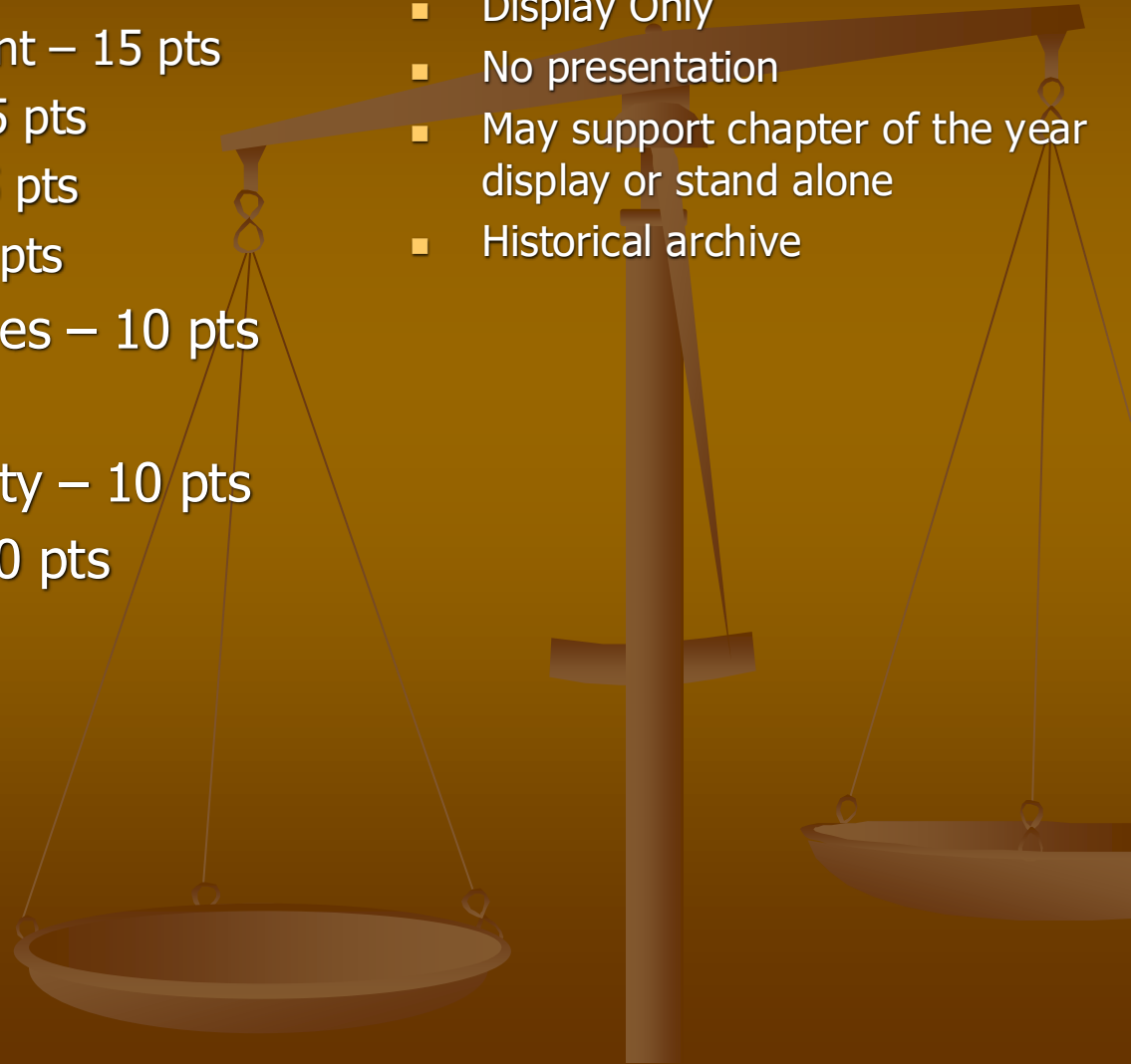

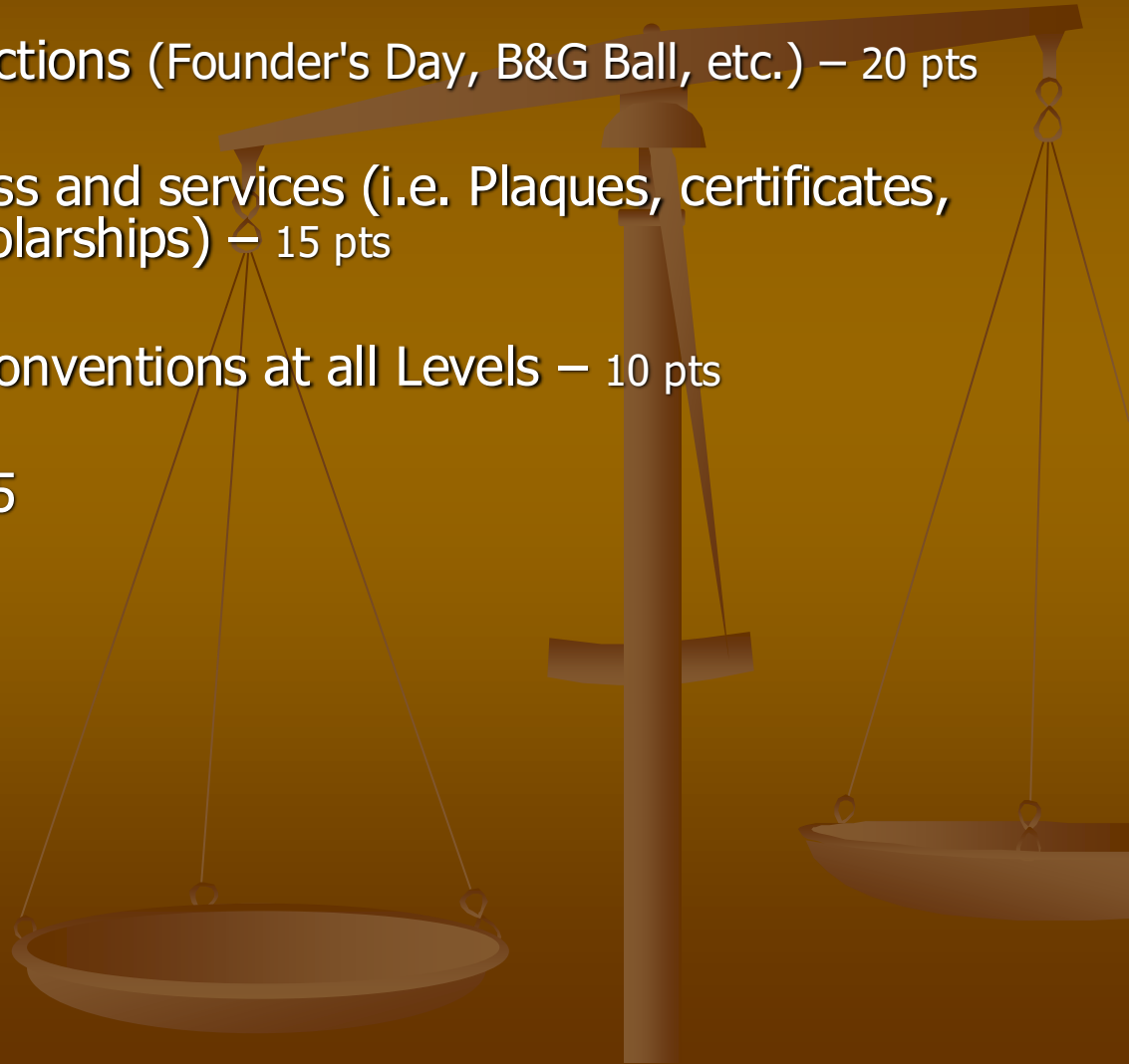

# Charles H. Wesley Award

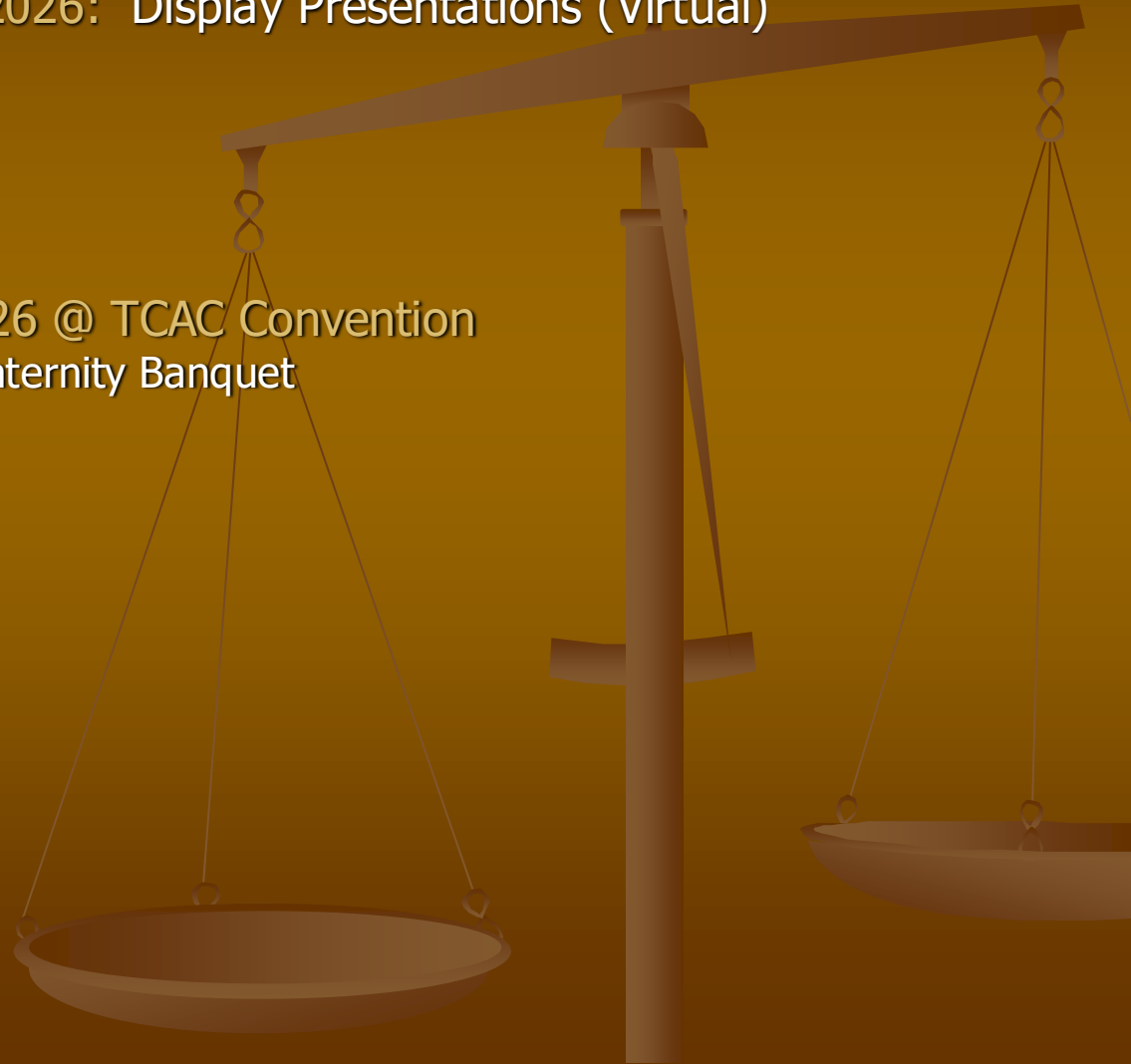
- National Programs and Special Projects – 30 pts

- Participation in Fraternal Conventions at all Levels – 10 pts
- Quality of Presentation - 15
- Judges Interview – 10 pts
